With the arrival of 2025, we are seeing quite a few changes at Ann's Adventures! We have now purchased and put in place a new computer software program that is designed especially for Ann's Adventures. As we are learning how to use this new system, we are asking for your understanding and patience! It may take us some time to figure out how to use it, but once we accomplish that, it should save us a lot of time. We should be able to look up information on individuals' trip status more quickly. We will likely be asking you for information to update our records if we are missing birthdates, addresses, phone numbers, etc. As we have been working on this project for the past 3 months, we've discovered that many phone numbers in our system are no longer valid. Many people have been letting go of their landlines and keeping only a cellphone.

The world of travel continues to see changes and we try very hard to keep aware of those changes to assist you in your travel choices. One such change has taken place this past month. Beginning January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025, travelers must have a VISA to travel to or through England (UK). Please see the article related to the change in this newsletter.

### **Travel Club Networking Meeting**

Travel Club Networking Meetings are held three times a year to allow people to provide ideas for future trips, meet with other travelers and get first-hand information about upcoming trips. They are in February, June and October. This is also a great meeting to attend to learn about travel tips and why I do the trips like I do.

### **Travel Certificates Make Great Gifts!**

Looking for the perfect gift? Travel Certificates are available in any amount! They can be used for any Ann's Adventures Trip! There is no expiration date! Tell your kids you want the gift of Travel! These make great gifts for retirement, birthdays, anniversaries, Mother's day, and Father's day or any Holiday like Christmas!

### **Do I need to send a deposit?**

A deposit assures your seat on a trip. When you call to put your name on a trip list, that lets me know how many people are interested. Your deposit (or full payment) assures you of a seat. Sometimes there are more names on the interest list than there are actual seats available.

When the maximum number of seats with money deposited are full, the rest becomes the wait list. The bottom line is... if you really want to go, you should put down a deposit. For day trips, a \$20.00 deposit will hold your seat. For extended trips, the deposit amount is listed at the top of the article. **The remaining balance for all trips is due 1 month prior to the trip unless specifically noted.**

### **What is cancellation protection?**

Cancellation Protection is a specified amount of money for overnight trips that is **due with your deposit** and protects all monies (except the cost of the cancellation protection) in the event of cancellation for any reason, anytime prior to departure. It is not insurance but does provide protection for the cost of your trip. Insurance is available and is included when we go overseas. Collette Trips include insurance and that would cover much more while we are in another country.

### **Making a Payment**

Payments can be made in cash, checks or money orders. I can take credit cards **however**, there will be a 4% charge added onto the payment if you decide to use a credit or debit card. Checks should be made out to Ann's Adventures. When sending checks, please write on the memo line what trip the check is for or use the form on the back page of this newsletter. It helps me get your payment posted to the right trip more quickly. If you would like a receipt, you should include a self-addressed, stamped envelope. There will be a \$15.00 charge for any check returned for insufficient funds.

### **Can I get a Refund?**

Refunds will be given only if there is a wait list and I am able to fill your place prior to departure. Partial refunds may be given if I am able to recover the costs of prepaid tickets, meals, etc. Cancellations and no-shows on the day of the trip will not be entitled to a refund. **Refund checks are issued after the trip is completed and can take a few months to process.** We often have to wait for refunds to come to us from the hotels, activities, etc, Thank you for understanding. Refund checks are issued to the person who paid for the trip. If your friend paid for your trip and you cancel, the refund is sent to the person who paid for you to go. In order for my books to match, the money refunded must match the person who paid it.

### **Why does it take so long to get a refund?**

The policy of sending refunds after the trip is completed is Ann's Adventures guidelines. It is in every newsletter where I say that all refunds are issued after the trip is completed! Why? Because it is easier for me to do all the refunds at the same time. Since we are trying to keep costs low for our travelers, I do not have the excess staff to be able to stop and send a refund on whatever day someone cancels a trip. It is much easier when the trip is finished and I can pay all final bills and send refunds at the same time. We often have to wait until venues return the money to us.

### **Driver Tips**

For all day trips, the driver tip is included in the cost of the trip. On overnight trips, we do pass an envelope for the driver and recommend \$2.00 to \$3.00 per person per day.

### **What makes a trip "sold out?"**

A trip can be "sold out" for several different reasons. It could be the number of tickets I purchased are all spoken for. It could be that the seats on the bus are all taken. In some cases, it may be that I can only get a certain number of hotel rooms at a particular location.

### **Become a STAR!**

I offer a special program for frequent travelers.

You can become a "STAR" which stands for Special Travel Adventure Rate! For only \$36.00 per year (from purchase date), you can become a STAR! As a result, every trip you sign up for will be \$6.00 less in cost. Therefore, if you travel at least 6 times in a year, you will have made your money back and for every trip after that, you come out ahead!

## TSA – Transportation Security Administration Acceptable Forms of ID

### 1 - REAL Michigan Driver's License –

Michigan is enacting a federally acceptable form of ID. **This will be in effect by May 7, 2025.** The REAL ID will be required for flying within the United States, entry into certain federal properties, entering nuclear facilities and military bases. **The Real ID Michigan Driver's license has a star in the upper right hand corner.**

**2 - Enhanced Michigan Driver's License** is already compliant and allows entry into the US by land or sea from Canada, Mexico, Bermuda or the Caribbean without a passport. **The Enhanced Michigan Driver's License has an American flag on the license just to the right of your picture. The newer ones also have a star in the upper right hand corner. It says "enhanced" at the top of the license.**

**3 - Passport** - is acceptable ID for any type of air flight to go anywhere. It is also acceptable for entry into certain federal facilities and entering nuclear facilities and military bases. It cannot be used as a driver's license. To fly into the US from anywhere – including Canada, Mexico, Bermuda, and the Caribbean, you must have a passport.

**Note! Please make sure you bring the correct identification to the bus for the trip you are taking! It truly hurts my heart to tell people they cannot go when I check their ID.**

### Medical Forms

Is your medical form up to date? A medical form ensures that I can give medical professionals correct information about your health in the event of a medical emergency. If something happens, they need to know your birthdate and list of current medications. If you need to update your form, I always carry extra on the trips. You can ask me for a form or call and I can email one to you. Or pick one up when you are in the office.

## UK ETA

## New Info!

This is a new UK entry requirement for US citizens planning to visit the UK. The ETA is a digital entry permit that will become mandatory for US travelers to the UK, even for short visits, beginning January 8th, 2025. The ETA is a digital permit designed to pre-authorize travelers before they arrive in the UK.

It is now mandatory for travelers from all visa-exempt countries traveling to the UK. The UK ETA will permit short stays for specific purposes, including:

- **Tourism:** For tourists interested in experiences like sightseeing, taking vacations, or visiting family and friends.
- **Business:** For attending meetings, conferences, or conducting other business-related activities.
- **Short-term study:** For courses or training lasting up to six months.
- **Transiting through the UK:** For travelers passing through the UK en route to another destination.
- **Creative Worker visa concession:** For coming to the UK for up to three months under this concession.
- **Permitted paid engagement:** For visiting the UK for certain paid engagements after meeting specific conditions.

The UK ETA aims to make the travel experience smoother and more efficient by allowing travelers to complete the necessary entry requirements before arriving in the UK. It will reduce wait times at the border and help authorities manage the entry of travelers more effectively.

The ETA will have a validity period of two years or until the holder's passport expires, whichever occurs first. Holders will be able to make multiple trips to the UK during this time, with each stay limited to six months, or three months for those entering the UK under the Creative Worker visa concession.

The application for the UK ETA will be entirely online. Applicants will need to provide personal information, passport details, and their travel plans. The required documents typically include:

- A valid passport
- A recent passport-sized photograph
- A valid email address

The processing time for the UK ETA is expected to be quick, within 72 hours and the application can be completed online.

**We will be able to help with this process in the office. You can call the office to make an appointment with Izzy. The cost is \$10.00.**

### Regarding New Passports...

Passports are available at the Clio Post Office by appointment. **You must go online to schedule your appointment. The other option is to go in on a Thursday morning between 9:00 a.m. and noon.**

**Check with your local post office as their times may vary.**

You need your birth certificate with a raised seal to apply for one. They are good for ten years. The post office can take your picture or you can get a passport photo taken at another location such as Walgreen's.

### Passport Renewals Now Available Online

Last year it was announced that individuals who need to renew their passports can now do so online. To make it easier for our travelers, we plan to offer assistance here in our office. You need to call and make an appointment as it will take about 40 minutes to complete. Please make sure you meet the following requirements to be able to renew online.

1. The passport you are renewing is or was valid for 10 years, and you are age 25 or older.
2. The passport you are renewing is either expiring within one year or has expired less than five years ago.
3. You are not changing your name, gender, date of birth, or place of birth.
4. You are not traveling for at least 8 weeks from the date you will submit your application. We will only offer routine service, and the time it takes to get a passport will be the same as renewing by mail.
5. You are applying for a regular (tourist) passport. You cannot renew a special issuance (diplomatic, official, service) passport online.
6. You live in the United States (either state or territory). You do not qualify to renew online if you live in a foreign country or have an Army Post Office (APO) or Fleet Post Office (FPO) address.
7. You have your passport with you, and it is not damaged or mutilated, and you have not reported it as lost or stolen. Keep your most recent passport and do not mail it to us.
8. You can pay for your passport using a credit or debit card.
9. We will take your photo for a digital upload.
10. You are aware that we will cancel the passport you are renewing after you submit your application. You cannot use it for international travel.

**You will need to bring your most recent passport, email and password, and credit or debit card for payment.**

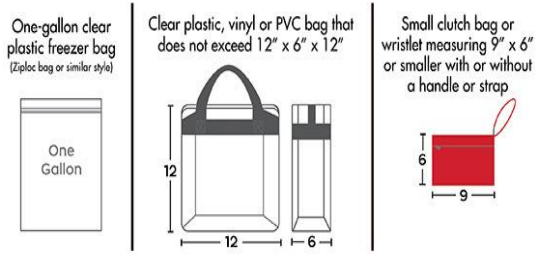

## W...ings for Travel

1. **Waking:** Every trip requires an early start. Begin setting your alarm a little earlier each day a couple weeks before the trip. Then it won't be such a shock to your system to suddenly be getting up so early every day.
2. **Walking:** If you are not a person who walks regularly, begin! Don't try to start with a mile or two right away. Try walking ten minutes a day then 20, then 30. It is amazing how much easier the trip will be for you if walking is not a shock to your system. You will definitely have more fun!
3. **Watering:** Drink more water! This is good for you even when not traveling. However, when we travel it is crucial that you not become dehydrated. Keeping your body hydrated will help you to be healthier and your system to work more efficiently.

## **In case you are wondering, here are some of my favorite trip tips!**

### **Ann's Trip Tips**

**Luggage** – Each person can bring 1 checked bag and 1 carryon. Your checked bag will be delivered to your room. You are responsible for your carryon. It should fit above your seat on the bus. You will not be able to access your checked bag during the day. Please put cameras and medications in your carry-on. A carry-on is the small bag you take onto the bus for things you may need during the day of travel. For airtickets, your checked bag should be less than 50 lbs and less than 62 linear inches!

### **Cell Phones**

You may want to check with your individual carrier about whether or not they have cell towers in our travel area. If they don't, you may just want to leave cell phone at home. If you do take your phone, don't forget your charger. Please be considerate and refrain from using the cell phone while on the motorcoach. There may not be Wi-Fi on the coach.

### **Money**

A credit card may be used for any purchases. It is advisable to notify your credit card company that you are going on a trip and that there may be unusual charges. You can get cash at an ATM machine with your debit card. Check with your bank for any additional fees. You must have a pin number for your debit card.

### **Clothing**

My suggestion: Lay out everything you think you need for the entire trip. Then put half of it away. You will most likely still have more than you need for the trip. Plan to dress in layers. You can add a layer on the cooler days and shed a layer if it warms up. This trip is completely casual... smart casual is acceptable everywhere. It can be cool in the evenings or by the water or in the bus. You might like to bring a sweatshirt or jacket. Smart Casual for the performance venues is acceptable.

### **Zip Lock Bags**

Large Zip Loc Bags come in handy to pack damp clothes so everything in your suitcase doesn't get wet. I also use zip loc bags for bottles that may leak such as lotion, shampoo, etc.

### **Walking Shoes**

It is important to have comfortable walking shoes. Do not buy new shoes right before the trip.

### **Purses/Wallets**

Ladies! Condense the contents of your purse. Take out anything you will not need on the trip. Take your **ID**, a major credit card and your medical card. Leave home any store credit cards, (Sears, Penneys). Leave your checkbook at home. These things take up room in your purse and you won't need them. Guys! Condense your wallet! Take only items you may need! Utilize your lanyards. They can keep things handy that you need.

### **Hotel Rooms**

Some hotels have limited outlets. With today's technology, you might want to include an extension cord. A night light to plug in a bathroom outlet is also helpful for those middle of the night trips. Many hotels are also offering room service upon request.

### **Seat Rotation**

We will use a seat rotation during the trip as this allows each person to see sights from a different perspective.

### **Refillable Water Bottle**

Please bring a refillable water bottle. It is important to stay hydrated. Carry it with you each day on the bus.

### **Distilled Water**

If you need distilled water for a c-pap machine, you can bring a jug with your name on it to put in a box under the bus. You will need to carry it to your room as it will not be included in the luggage count. Another option is to purchase small bottles of distilled water in the baby section of the department store and put them in your suitcase.

### **Window Containers**

Some people find that getting a "shower caddy" in the bathroom section of any department store is handy to suction on the window by your seat. You can place items in there during the trip such as a drinking cup, a magazine, puzzle book, etc.

### **Airport Security**

Slip on shoes make going through security easier. If you are over 75 years of age, you must remove your shoes. Shoes and jackets must be removed and all pockets must be emptied when going through security. No liquids over 3 ounces in your carry-ons. Any scissors or manicure sets must be in your checked luggage.
